Product Details

Background:	Secreted as part of the adaptive immune response by plasma B cells, immunoglobulin G constitutes 75% of serum immunoglobulins. Immunoglobulin G binds to viruses, bacteria, as well as fungi and facilitates their destruction or neutralization via agglutination (and thereby immobilizing them), activation of the complement cascade, and opsonization for phagocytosis. This antibody possesses the F(c) region, recognized by high-affinity Fc receptor proteins.

Target Details

Purity/Specificity:	This product was prepared from normal serum by a multi-step process which includes delipidation, salt fractionation, ion exchange chromatography and papain digestion followed by chromatographic separation and extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Chicken Serum, anti-Chicken IgG and anti-Chicken IgG F(c). No reaction was observed against anti-Chicken IgG F(ab') ₂ or anti-Papain.

Application Note:	Chicken IgG F(c) fragment has been tested by SDS-PAGE and can be utilized as a control or standard reagent in Western Blotting and ELISA experiments.

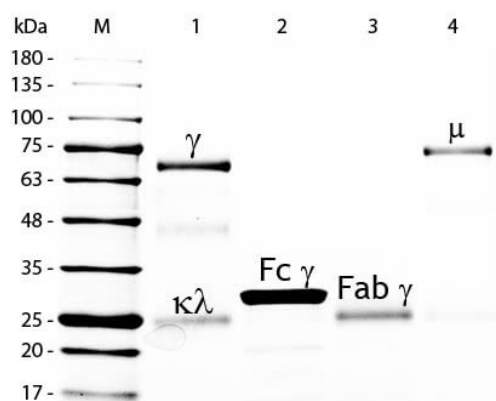

Concentration:	1.0 mg/mL by UV absorbance at 280 nm
Buffer:	0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2
Preservative:	0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide
Stabilizer:	None

Shipping & Handling

Shipping Condition:	Wet Ice
Storage Condition:	Store vial at 4° C prior to opening. Stable at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. For extended storage, aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing.
Expiration:	Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.

SDS-PAGE of Chicken IgG/IgY Whole Molecule Rhodamine Conjugated (p/n 003-0002). Lane M: 5 μ L Opal Prestained Marker (p/n MB-210-0500). Lane 1: Reduced Chicken IgG Whole Molecule Rhodamine Conjugated (p/n 003-0002). Lane 2: Reduced Chicken IgG F(c) Fragment (p/n 003-0103). Lane 3: Reduced Chicken IgG Fab Fragment (p/n 003-0105). Lane 4: Reduced Chicken IgM Whole Molecule (p/n 003-0107). Load: 1 μ g per lane. Predicted/Observed size: IgG at 72 and 25 kDa; F(c) at 25 kDa; Fab at 25 kDa; IgM at 75 kDa. Observed F(c) Fragment migrates slightly higher. Other bands: Chicken IgG heavy chain alternative splicing variant at approximately 40 kDa in Lane 1.
