Background:	Anti-TRAF6 Binding Protein Antibody detects human TRAF6BP. A TRAF-interacting protein that specifically associates with TRAF6, TRAF6BP (TAX1BP) shares an overall 50% identity and 59% similarity to a recently identified chicken protein MDP62, which has been implicated in promoting neurite outgrowth. TRAF6BP-TRAF6 complex formation is dependent on the presence of the IL-1 receptor-associated kinase (IRAK). Anti-TRAF6BP Antibody is ideal for investigators involved in Toll Like Receptors, signaling, cytokine and growth factor research.

A BLAST analysis was used to suggest cross-reactivity with TRAF6 BP from human based on 100% homology with the immunizing sequence. Cross-reactivity with Anti-TRAF6BP from other sources has not been determined.

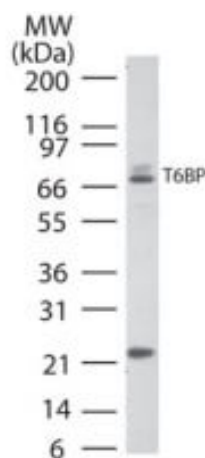

Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

Secondary antibody: IRDye800™ rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Block: 5% BLOTTO overnight at 4°C. Predicted/Observed size: 80 kDa for TRAF6BP. Other band(s): none.
