Background:	Bovine Serum Albumin antibody detects BSA. Serum albumin is the main protein of plasma. It has a good binding capacity for water, Ca ²⁺ , Na ⁺ , K ⁺ , fatty acids, hormones, bilirubin and drugs. Its main function is the regulation of the colloidal osmotic pressure of blood. ALB is the major zinc transporter in plasma; it typically binds about 80% of all plasma zinc. BSA antibody is ideal for investigators involved in Cell Signaling, Neuroscience and Signal Transduction research.

Immunogen:	Anti-Bovine Serum Albumin antibody was produced by repeated immunizations with bovine serum albumin.

Purity/Specificity: Bovine Serum Albumin antibody is an IgG fraction antibody purified from monospecific antiserum by a multi-step process which includes delipidation, salt fractionation and ion exchange chromatography followed by extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rabbit Serum as well as purified and partially purified Albumin (Bovine Serum). Cross reactivity against Albumin from other tissues and species may occur but has not been specifically determined.

Application Note: Anti-Bovine Serum Albumin (BSA) antibody has been tested by western blot and ELISA and is suitable in dot blot, immunoprecipitation, conjugation and most immunological methods requiring high titer and specificity.

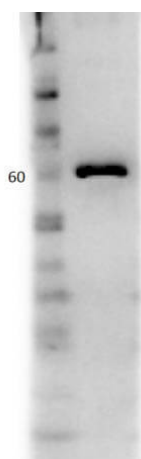
Shipping & Handling

Shipping Condition: Ambient

Storage Condition: Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

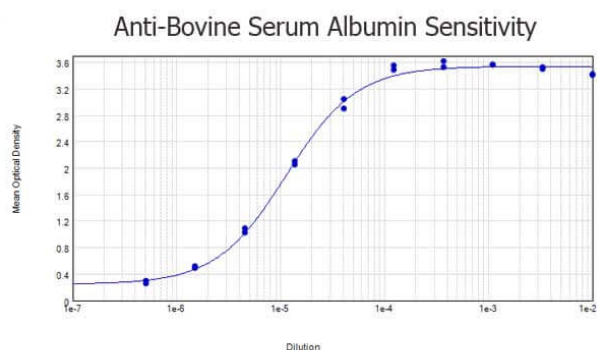
Expiration: Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.

Western Blot

Western Blot of Rabbit Anti-BSA Antibody. Lane 1: Molecular Weight Marker. Lane 2: BSA. Primary Antibody: Rabbit anti-Bovine Serum Albumin at 1:1000 overnight at 2-8°C. Secondary Antibody: Goat anti-Rabbit Peroxidase conjugated (p/n 611-103-122) at 1:40000 for 30min at RT. Blocking: 5% goat serum.



ELISA

ELISA results of purified Rabbit anti-Bovine Serum Albumin Antibody tested against Bovine Serum Albumin. Each well was coated in duplicate with 1.0 µg of the antigen. The starting dilution of antibody was 5µg/ml and the X-axis represents the Log10 of a 3-fold dilution. This titration is a 4-parameter curve fit where the IC50 is defined as the titer of the antibody. Assay performed using 3% fish gel, Goat anti-Rabbit IgG Antibody Peroxidase Conjugated (Min X Bv Ch Gt GP Ham Hs Hu Ms Rt & Sh Serum Proteins) (p/n 611-103-122) and TMB ELISA Peroxidase Substrate (p/n TMBE-1000).
