Background:	Fanconi anemia group E protein (FANCE) is part of the Fanconi anemia (FA) complex functions in DNA cross-links repair. It is required for the nuclear accumulation of FANCC and provides a critical bridge between the FA complex and FANCD2.

Immunogen:	This affinity purified antibody was prepared from whole rabbit serum produced by repeated immunizations with a synthetic peptide corresponding to amino acids 1-13 of Human FANCE. This Fanconi anemia protein promotes the nuclear accumulation of FANCC. FANCE protein is part of the FA nuclear complex, binding FANCC & FANCD2. It is required for the nuclear accumulation of FANCC and provides a bridge between the FA complex and FANCD2. FANCC mutants do not bind FANCE or prevent chromosome breakage. Purity/Specificity: This is an affinity purified antibody produced by immunoaffinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide after immobilization to a solid phase.

Storage Condition: Store vial at -20° C prior to opening. Aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below for extended storage. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
