| <b>Background:</b>   | The FERM and PDZ domain containing (FRMPD) protein family consists of four proteins that contain a FERM (Four-point-one, erzin, radixin, moesin) domain and at least one PDZ (PSD-95/Discs large/Zonula-occludens-1) domain. FRMPD4, also known as Preso, also contains another protein interaction domain termed WW (domain with two conserved Trp residues) at its amino terminus. It was identified through a yeast two-hybrid screen using the PDZ domain of PSD-95 as bait and is highly expressed in multiple regions of the brain and is enriched in the postsynaptic density (PSD) fractions. Overexpression of FRMPD4 in cultured hippocampal neurons significantly increased the linear density of dendritic spines without changing their length and width; conversely, knockdown experiments using RNAi caused a decrease in spine density, indicating FRMPD4 positively regulates dendritic spine density but not morphology. The decreased level of FRMPD4 also resulted in reduced levels of excitatory synaptic transmission, suggesting that FRMPD4 is required for maintenance of excitatory synaptic transmission. |

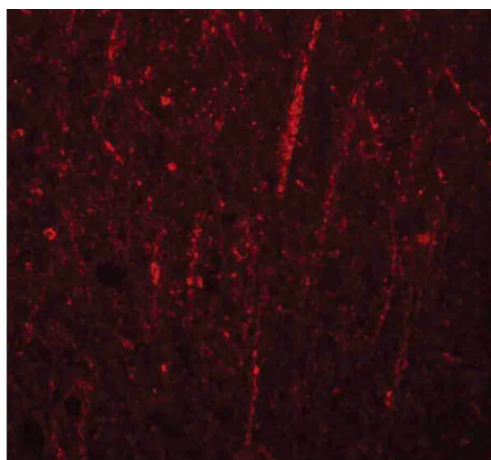

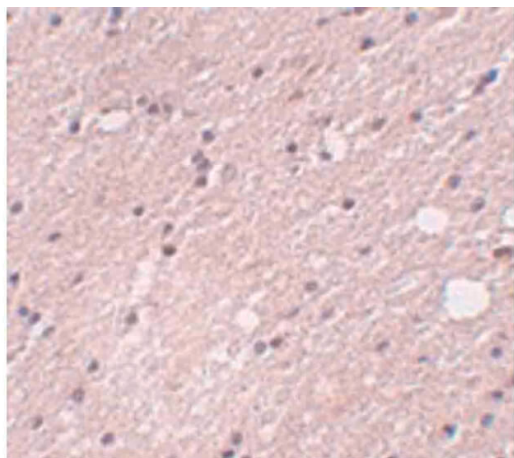

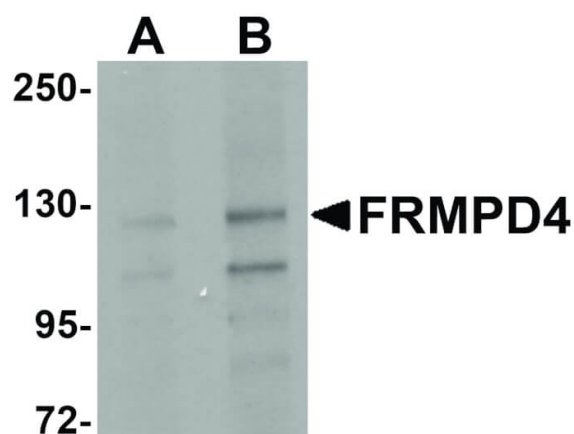
### Immunofluorescence Microscopy

Immunofluorescence Microscopy of FRMPD4 antibody.  
Tissue: human brain tissue. Fixation: 0.5% PFA. Antigen retrieval: not required. Primary antibody: FRMPD4 antibody at 20 µg/mL for 1 h at RT. Secondary antibody: Fluorescein rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Localization: FRMPD4 is a membrane protein. Staining: FRMPD4 as red fluorescent signal.



### Immunohistochemistry

Immunohistochemistry of FRMPD4 antibody. Tissue: Human brain tissue. Fixation: formalin fixed paraffin embedded. Antigen retrieval: not required. Primary antibody: FRMPD4 antibody at 5 µg/mL for 1 h at RT. Secondary antibody: Peroxidase rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Localization: FRMPD4 is a membrane protein. Staining: FRMPD4 as precipitated brown signal with purple nuclear counterstain.



#### Western Blot

Western Blot of FRMPD4 antibody. Lane 1: SK-N-SH cell lysate with FRMPD4 antibody at 1 µg/mL. Lane 2: SK-N-SH cell lysate with FRMPD4 antibody at 2 µg/mL. Secondary antibody: Peroxidase rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Block: 5% BLOTTO overnight at 4°C. Predicted/Observed size: 151 kDa, 130 kDa for FRMPD4. Other band(s): FRMPD4 splice variants and isoforms.
