Product Details

Background:	A novel cytokine related to IL2 and IL15 was recently identified and designated IL-21. The receptor for IL-21 (IL-21R, also termed NILR for novel Interleukin receptor) is a new member of the class I cytokine receptor family. IL-21R forms a complex with the common cytokine receptor gamma chain, gammac, and mediates IL-21 signaling. Both IL-21R and the gc are necessary for the IL-21 function. IL-21 and its receptor activate JAK-STAT signaling pathway. IL-21R is expressed in spleen, thymus, natural killer (NK), T and B cell lines. IL-21 plays a role in the proliferation and maturation of NK, B and T cell populations.

Purity/Specificity: Anti-IL-21 Receptor Antibody was affinity purified from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography. Cross reactivity with IL-21 Receptor from other sources has not been determined.

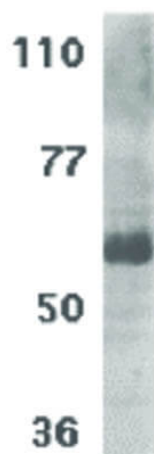
Shipping & Handling

Shipping Condition: Dry Ice

Storage Condition: Store vial at -20° C prior to opening. Aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below for extended storage. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

Expiration: Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.

Western Blot of IL-21 receptor antibody. Lane 1: Raji cell lysate. Load: 35 µg per lane. Primary antibody: IL-21 receptor antibody at 1 µg/mL for overnight at 4°C. Secondary antibody: Peroxidase rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Block: 5% BLOTTO overnight at 4°C. Predicted/Observed size: 59.1 kDa, 70 kDa for IL-21 receptor.
