Background:	KLRA2 (also known as Ly49B) is a member of the LY49 family of receptors in Natural Killer (NK) cells that bind to major histocompatibility complex (MHC) class 1. These proteins are classified as either activating or inhibitory receptors based on whether they possess an immunoreceptor tyrosine-based inhibitory motif (ITIM) in their cytoplasmic region (for inhibitory receptors), or an immunoreceptor tyrosine-based activation motif (ITAM) that transmits activating signals resulting in phosphorylation of several substrates. KLRA2 is thought to be an inhibitory receptor and associates with the protein tyrosine phosphatases SHP1, SHP2, and SHIP in transfected cells. This antibody is predicted to not cross-react with other LY49 receptors.

Immunogen:	Anti-KLRA2 antibody was prepared from whole rabbit serum produced by repeated immunizations with a 14 amino acid synthetic peptide near the C-terminus of mouse KLRA2.

Purity/Specificity: Anti-KLRA2 Antibody was affinity purified from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography. Cross reactivity with KLRA2 from other sources has not been determined.

Tested Applications: ELISA, IF, IHC, WB

Application Note: Anti-KLRA2 Antibody has been tested for use in ELISA, Western Blotting, Immunohistochemistry and Immunofluorescence. Specific conditions for reactivity should be optimized by the end user. Expect a band at approximately 34 kDa in Western Blots of specific cell lysates and tissues.

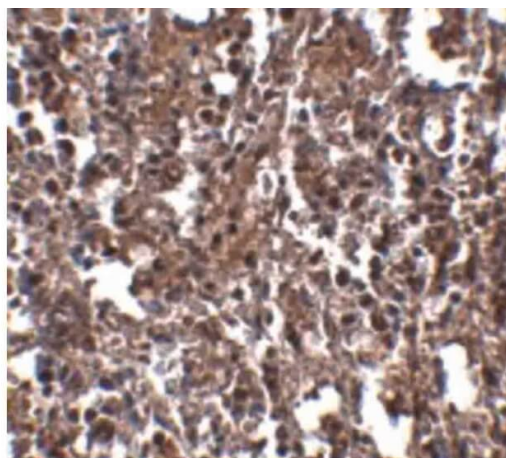
Shipping & Handling

Shipping Condition: Dry Ice

Storage Condition: Store vial at -20° C prior to opening. Aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below for extended storage. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

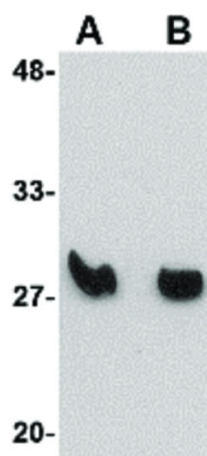
Expiration: Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.

Immunohistochemistry

Immunohistochemistry of KLRA2 antibody. Tissue: Mouse spleen tissue. Fixation: formalin fixed paraffin embedded. Antigen retrieval: not required. Primary antibody: KLRA2 antibody at 2.5 µg/mL for 1 h at RT. Secondary antibody: Peroxidase rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Localization: KLRA2 is a single pass type II membrane protein. Staining: KLRA2 as precipitated brown signal with hematoxylin purple nuclear counterstain.



Western Blot

Western Blot of KLRA1 antibody. Lane A: Mouse spleen tissue lysate at 1 µg/mL. Lane B: Mouse spleen tissue lysate at 2 µg/mL. Load: 35 µg per lane. Secondary antibody: Peroxidase rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Block: 5% BLOTTO overnight at 4°C. Predicted/Observed size: 33.6 kDa, ~28 kDa for KLRA1.
