| <b>Background:</b>   | LMBRD1, also known as NESI (nuclear export signal-interacting protein, is a lysosomal membrane protein that is thought be involved in the transport and metabolism of cobalamin. LMBRD1 was initially identified as interacting with the large form of the hepatitis delta antigen and may be required for the nucleocytoplasmic shuttling of the hepatitis delta virus. Mutations in this gene are associated with the vitamin B12 metabolism disorder termed, homocystinuria-megaloblastic anemia complementation type F (cblF). |

**Tested Applications:** ELISA, IF, IHC, WB

**Application Note:** Anti-LMBRD1 Antibody has been tested for use in ELISA, Western Blotting, Immunohistochemistry and Immunofluorescence. 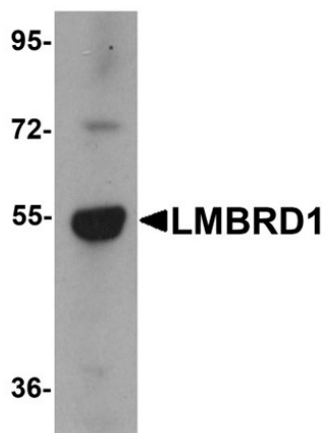
## Shipping & Handling

**Shipping Condition:** Dry Ice

**Storage Condition:** Store vial at -20° C prior to opening. Aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below for extended storage. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

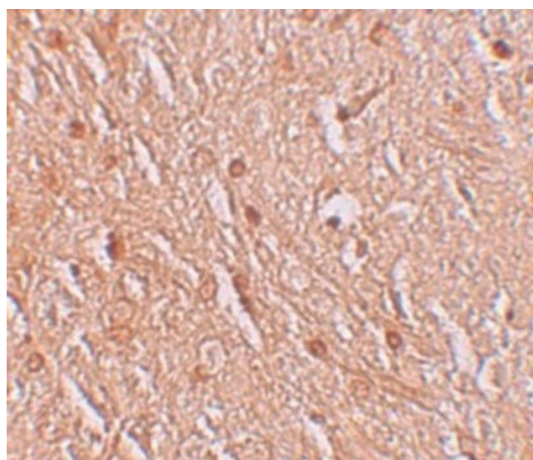

Load: human brain tissue lysate.

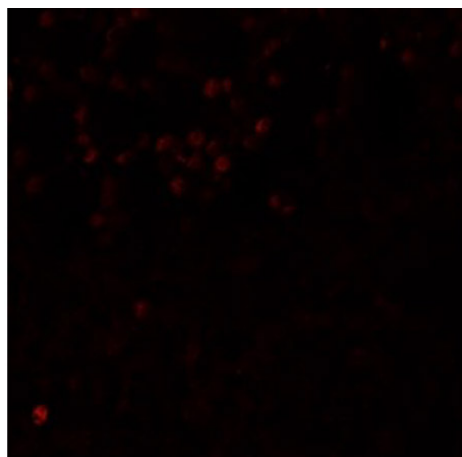
Primary Antibody: Anti-LMBRD1 antibody at 1 µg/mL.
