Background:	The LRRC26 protein was initially identified as a cytokeratin-associated protein whose expression was elevated in multiple cancer cell lines and cancer specimens as well in normal prostate and salivary gland tissues (1). LRRC26 was later found to negatively regulate the NF-kappaB activation and suppresses tumor growth and metastasis (2). LRRC26 can also act to selectively alter the efficacy of large conductance calcium-activated K (BK) channels (3).

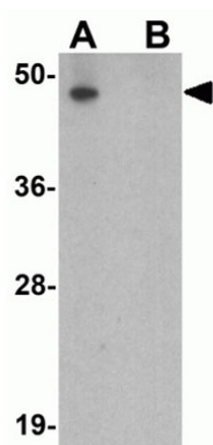

Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

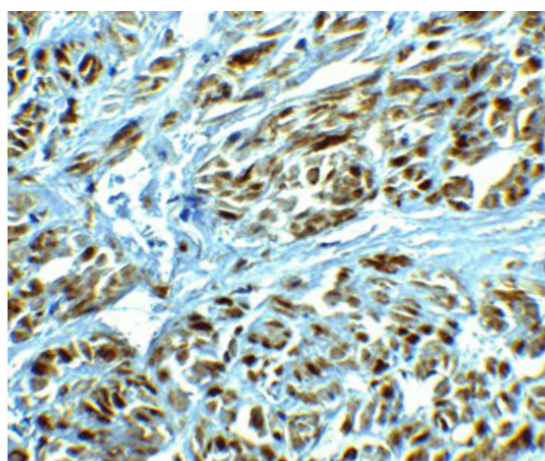


Western Blot

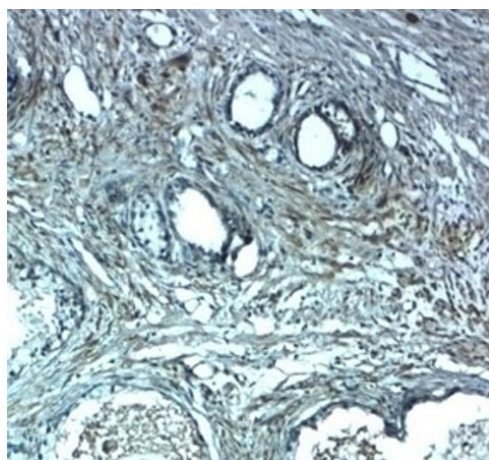


Immunohistochemistry

Primary Antibody: LRRC26 antibody at 2.5 $\mu\text{g}/\text{ml}$.

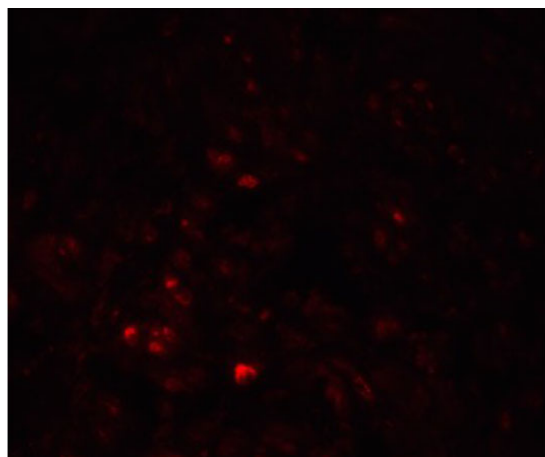


Immunohistochemistry
