Product Details

Background:	TRIM5 is a member of a broad family of otherwise unrelated proteins defined by the presence of a tripartite motif containing a RING domain, a B-box type 1, and a B-box type 2, followed by a coiled-coil region. TRIM5 has six alternately spliced isoforms, the longest of which is the alpha variant which also contains a carboxy-terminal B30.2 (SPRY) domain. Expression of TRIM5a variants from humans, rhesus monkeys, and African green monkeys enabled resistance to infection by various retroviruses including HIV-1, albeit at differing efficiencies. All TRIM5a variants could inhibit at least two different retroviruses, but not from those viruses isolated from the same species, suggesting that TRIM5a acts as a natural barrier to cross-species retrovirus transmission.

Immunogen:	Anti-TRIM5 alpha antibody was prepared from whole rabbit serum produced by repeated immunizations with a synthetic peptide corresponding to amino acids near the internal region of rhesus monkey TRIM5 alpha.
Purity/Specificity:	Anti-TRIM5 alpha Antibody was affinity purified from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography. Cross reactivity with TRIM5 alpha from other sources has not been determined.

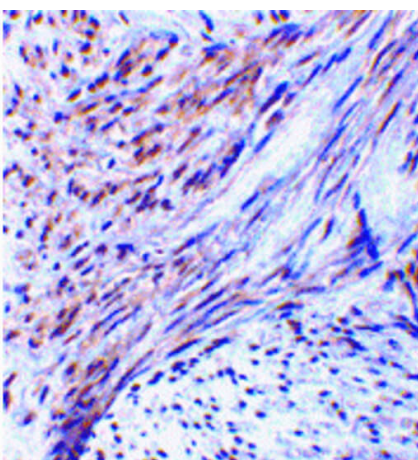
Shipping & Handling

Shipping Condition:	Dry Ice
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Storage Condition: Store vial at -20° C prior to opening. Aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below for extended storage. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

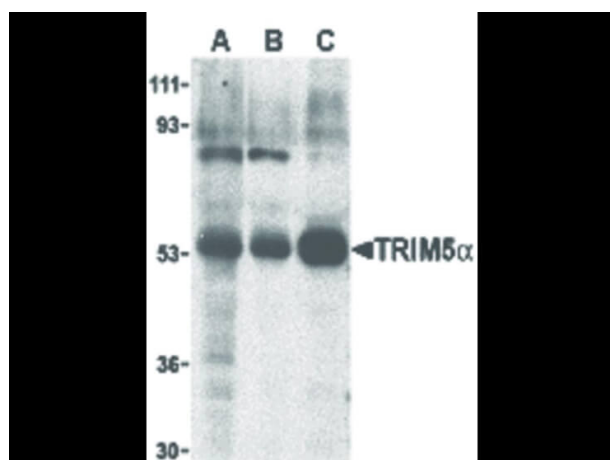
Expiration: Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.

Immunohistochemistry

Immunohistochemistry of TRIM5 alpha antibody. Tissue: human uterus tissue. Fixation: formalin fixed paraffin embedded. Antigen retrieval: not required. Primary antibody: TRIM5 alpha antibody at 2 µg/mL for 1 h at RT. Secondary antibody: Peroxidase rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Localization: TRIM5 alpha is cytoplasmic. Staining: TRIM5 alpha is stained with Toluidine blue.



Western Blot

Western Blot of TRIM5 alpha antibody. Lane A: human stomach cell lysate. Lane B: human thymus cell lysate. Lane C: human uterus cell lysate. Load: 35 µg per lane. Primary antibody: TRIM5 alpha antibody at 2 µg /ml for overnight at 4°C. Secondary antibody: Peroxidase rabbit secondary antibody at 1:10,000 for 45 min at RT. Block: 5% BLOTTO overnight at 4°C. Predicted/Observed size: 71 kDa, 55 kDa for TRIM5 alpha. Other band(s): TRIM5 alpha splice variants and isoforms.
