Background:	The Ubiquitin-like containing PHD and RING finger domains 1-binding protein 1 (UHRF1BP1), also known as ICBP90, is a transcription and cell cycle regulator. It specifically binds to the histone H3 N-terminal tail when methylated on K9 by two functional domains, a PHD finger that defines the binding specificity and an SRA (SET- and RING-associated) domain that promotes binding activity. UHRF1BP1 is required for proper heterochromatin formation in mammalian cells. Furthermore, UHRF1BP1 is thought to be a pivotal target for the ERK1/2 signaling pathway to control the proliferation of Jurkat T cells.

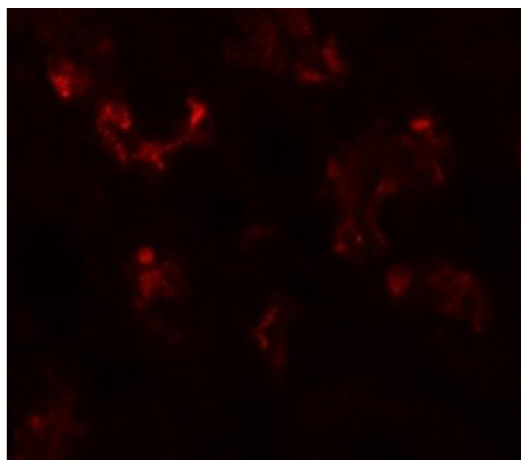

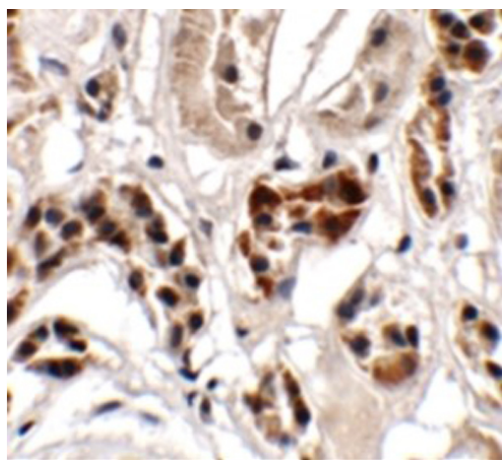
Shipping Condition:	Dry Ice
Storage Condition:	Store vial at -20° C prior to opening. Aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below for extended storage. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

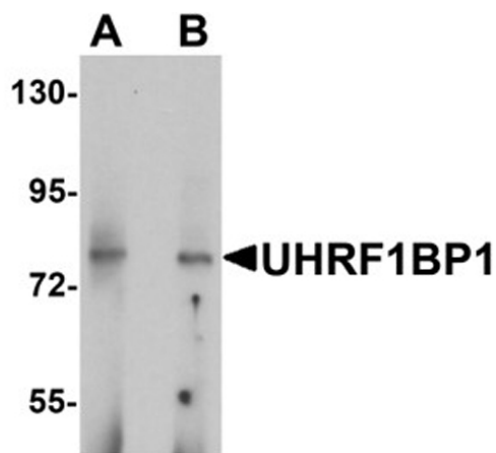
