Background:	Andes virus (ANDV) is a rodent-borne hantavirus of the family Bunyaviridae, an enveloped, negative-sense RNA viruses with a tripartite genome that can cause hantavirus pulmonary syndrome (HPS) (1). It was isolated from an infected <i>Oligoryzomys longicaudatus</i> rodent in Chile, and is highly similar to the Sin Nombre virus (SNV).

Purity/Specificity:	Anti-Andes Virus Glycoprotein antibody was affinity purified from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography. Cross reactivity with Andes Virus Glycoprotein from other sources has not been determined.

Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
