TH antibodies can therefore be used as markers for dopaminergic and noradrenergic neurons in a variety of applications including depression, schizophrenia, Parkinson's disease and drug abuse. TH antibodies can also be used to explore basic mechanisms of dopamine and norepinephrine signaling. |

**Tested Applications:** IHC, WB

**Application Note:** Anti-Tyrosine Hydroxylase (Sheep) antibody is tested for use in Western Blotting, IHC and ICC. Specific conditions for reactivity should be optimized by the end user. Expect a band of approximately 60 kDa in size corresponding to tyrosine hydroxylase protein in the appropriate cell lysate or extract.

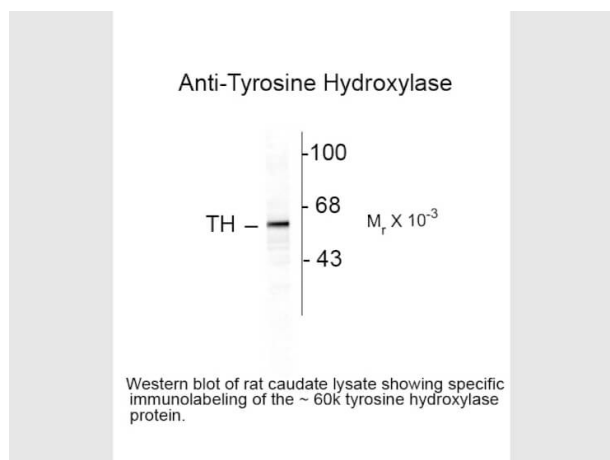
## Shipping & Handling
