Product Details

Background:	Anti-Chicken IgG F(ab') ₂ Antibody generated in rabbit is a proteolytic fragment of immunoglobulin G (IgG) obtained by limited digestion with the enzyme pepsin under controlled conditions of temperature, time and pH. F(ab') ₂ molecules lack the Fc portion of IgG and therefore receptors that bind Chicken IgG F(c) will not bind Chicken IgG F(ab') ₂ molecules.

Purity/Specificity:	This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Chicken IgG coupled to agarose beads. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-biotin, anti-Rabbit Serum, Chicken IgG, Chicken IgG F(ab') ₂ and Chicken Serum. No reaction was observed against Chicken IgG F(c).

Application Details

Application Note:	This product has been assayed against 1.0 ug of Chicken IgG in a standard capture ELISA using Peroxidase Conjugated Streptavidin #S000-03 and ABTS (2,2'-azino-bis-[3-ethylbenthiazoline-6-sulfonic acid]) code # ABTS-100 as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:8,000 to 1:34,000 of the reconstitution concentration is suggested for this product.

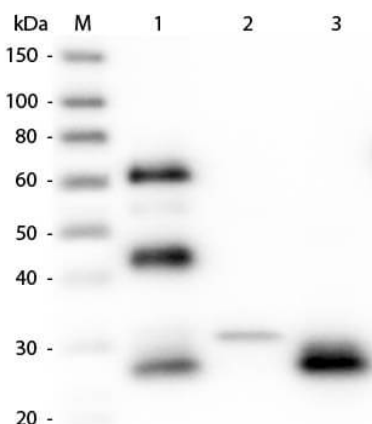

Physical State:	Lyophilized
Concentration:	1.5 mg/mL by UV absorbance at 280 nm
Buffer:	0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2
Preservative:	0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide
Stabilizer:	10 mg/mL Bovine Serum Albumin (BSA) - Immunoglobulin and Protease free
Reconstitution Volume:	1.0 mL
Reconstitution Buffer:	Restore with deionized water (or equivalent)

Shipping & Handling

Shipping Condition:	Ambient
Storage Condition:	Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
Expiration:	Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.

Western Blot of Unconjugated Anti-Chicken IgG F(ab')₂ (RABBIT) Antibody (p/n 603-4104). Lane M: 3 µl Molecular Ladder. Lane 1: Chicken IgG whole molecule (p/n 003-0102). Lane 2: Chicken IgG F(c) Fragment (p/n 003-0103). Lane 3: Chicken IgG F(ab) Fragment (p/n 003-0105). All samples were reduced. Load: 50 ng per lane. Block: MB-070 for 30 min at RT. Primary Antibody: Anti-Chicken IgG F(ab')₂ (RABBIT) Antibody (p/n 603-4104) 1:5,000 for 60 min at RT. Secondary antibody: Anti-Rabbit IgG (GOAT) Peroxidase Conjugated Antibody (p/n 611-103-122) 1:40,000 in MB-070 for 30 min at RT. Predicted/Observed Size: 25 and 72 kDa for Chicken IgY, 25 kDa for F(c) and F(ab). Chicken F(c) migrates slightly higher.
