Product Details

Background:	Anti-Golden Syrian Hamster IgG Antibody generated in rabbit detects Golden Syrian Hamster IgG. Secreted as part of the adaptive immune response by plasma B cells, immunoglobulin G constitutes 75% of serum immunoglobulins. Immunoglobulin G binds to viruses, bacteria, as well as fungi and facilitates their destruction or neutralization via agglutination (and thereby immobilizing them), activation of the complement cascade, and opsonization for phagocytosis. The whole IgG molecule possesses both the F(c) region, recognized by high-affinity Fc receptor proteins, as well as the F(ab) region possessing the epitope-recognition site. Both heavy and light chains of the antibody molecule are present. Secondary Antibodies are available in a variety of formats and conjugate types. When choosing a secondary antibody product, consideration must be given to species and immunoglobulin specificity, conjugate type, fragment and chain specificity, level of cross-reactivity, and host-species source and fragment composition.

Purity/Specificity:	This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Hamster IgG coupled to agarose beads. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rabbit Serum, Golden Syrian Hamster IgG and Golden Syrian Hamster Serum. Greatly reduced reactivity will occur against Armenian Hamster IgG.

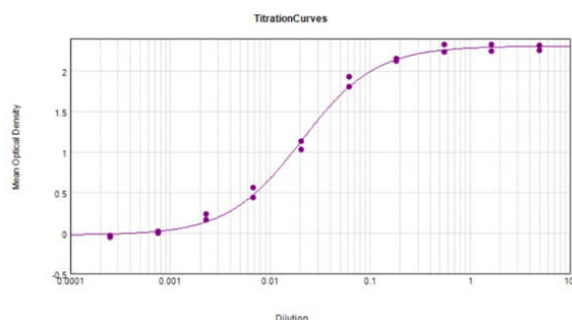

Shipping Condition:	Wet Ice
Storage Condition:	Store vial at 4° C prior to opening. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing.
Expiration:	Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.

ELISA Results of Purified Rabbit Anti-Golden Syrian Hamster IgG Antibody tested against purified Golden Syrian Hamster IgG. Each well was coated in duplicate with 1.0 μg of Golden Syrian Hamster IgG (p/n 007-0102). The starting dilution of antibody was 5 $\mu\text{g}/\text{ml}$ and the X-axis represents the Log10 of a 3-fold dilution. This titration is a 4-parameter curve fit where the IC50 is defined as the titer of the antibody. Assay performed using Donkey Anti-Rabbit IgG mx8 HRP conjugate (p/n 611-703-127) and TMB substrate (p/n TMBE-1000).
