Background:	Anti-Human IgM Fc5 μ antibody generated in rabbit specifically detects Fc5 μ portion of the human IgM heavy chain. Immunoglobulin M is the largest antibody isotype and the first to be secreted against an initial exposure to antigen. IgM is predominantly produced in the spleen. Formed from covalently linking 5 immunoglobulins together. Due to this large size, IgM is typically isolated to the serum. Anti-Human IgM Fc5 μ antibody is ideal for investigators in Immunology, Microbiology, and Cell Biology.

Immunogen:	Anti-Human IgM Fc5 μ was produced by repeated immunization with Human IgM Fc5 μ fragment in rabbit.

Purity/Specificity:	Human IgM Fc5 μ Antibody was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using antigens coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rabbit Serum, Human IgM and Human Serum. No reaction was observed against Human IgG or Human IgA.

Application Note:	Human IgM Fc5 μ antibody has been tested by ELISA and is suitable for immunoblotting (western or dot blot), ELISA, and immunohistochemistry requiring extremely low background levels, lot-to-lot consistency, high titer and specificity.

Shipping Condition:	Wet Ice
Storage Condition:	Store vial at 4° C prior to opening. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing.
Expiration:	Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.
