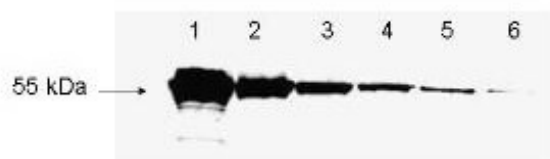

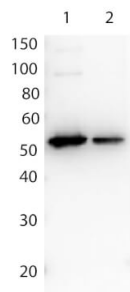
Western Blot
